Green Scene 2020: April 4 and April 5

General Information

The 2020 Green Scene Plant & Garden Expo will take place on the first weekend in April.

Saturday, April 4 (9 am – 4 pm) and **Sunday, April 5** (10 am – 4 pm)

The Event will be marketed through all Arboretum social media platforms, on its website (www.FullertonArboretum.org) and in printed media.

Application/Registration

Receipt of a registration form for participation in the 2020 Green Scene Plant & Garden Expo (Event) does not constitute acceptance into the Event and does not guarantee a space. Application/registration acceptance, space placement, and special requests are at the sole discretion of Arboretum management staff.

All participants in the Event (including, but not limited to, Commercial vendors, Educational organizations, Non-Profit Societies, Clubs, and Food vendors) shall be referred to as “Vendors” throughout Event documents.

Set-Up

- Vendors must select a date for set-up when completing the Registration form.
- If no date is selected, one will be assigned at the discretion of the Arboretum staff.
- Set-up dates and times are as follows:

Pre-Event

Thursday	April 2	1:00 am – 3:00 pm	No admission after 3 pm; vehicles must be out by 4:30 pm
Friday	April 3	9:00 am – 4:00 pm	No admission after 4 pm; vehicles must be out by 4:30 pm

Note: No vehicle entrance or exit between 12:00 noon and 1:15 pm on Friday

Event Mornings

Saturday	April 4	7:00 am – 8:00 am	No admission after 8 am; vehicles must be out by 8:30 am
Sunday	April 5	8:30 am – 9:00 am	No admission after 9 am; vehicles must be out by 9:30 am

Take-Down

- Vendors may take down booths no earlier than 4 pm on Sunday, April 5.
- Vehicles will not be permitted inside until 4:30 pm, after visitors have vacated the Arboretum.
- Vendors must vacate the grounds no later than 5:30 pm on Sunday unless previous arrangements have been made with Arboretum management staff.
- Refer also to **Rules and Code of Conduct**.

Vehicles on the Grounds

- The speed limit is 5 mph on the Arboretum grounds.
- Only one vehicle per booth may enter for set-up at a time.
- Vehicles should be unloaded as quickly as possible and moved from the Arboretum to Vendor Parking in Lot G. It is an easy walk back to complete set-up.

Parking

- No vendor parking is allowed in the Arboretum maintenance lot at any time during the Event.
- Thursday and Friday: Parking is available in Lot G (directly across from the Arboretum parking lot). Daily parking fees apply.
- Saturday and Sunday: Parking is available in Lot G. There is no cost to park in Lot G on the weekend.

Security

- Overnight security will be provided by CSUF University Police Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 6:00 pm to 6:00 am.

Vendor Relations

- Prior to the Event, Vendor wristbands will be available for pick-up at the Nature Center when booths are set-up.
- During the Event, vendor wristbands may be picked-up at the Vendor Relations booth.
- The wristband must be worn by all vendors and their staff to enter the Event and should be worn at all times during the Event.
- Each individual working in a booth must have their own wristband. NO SHARING WRISTBANDS.
- If additional wristbands are required, they are available for purchase.

Non-Transferable

- Vendors shall not transfer, assign, sublet, or share any assigned booth.
- Only product described on the Registration Form may displayed or sold at the Event.
- Soliciting or demonstrating with product or advertising materials is not permitted outside the Vendor's booth space.

California Seller's Permit / Sales Tax

- All vendors (including non-profits) must have a VALID California Seller's Permit and comply with all California sales tax laws.
- The Fullerton Arboretum Authority and Friends of the Fullerton Arboretum are not be liable for the collection and payment of any sales tax.

Health and Safety Codes

- Vendors must comply with CSUF Health and Safety requirements, California Department of Food & Agriculture, California State Fire Marshall and the California State Board of Equalization codes.

Asian Citrus Psyllid

- Orange County is currently under quarantine for Asian Citrus Psyllid, *Diaphorina citri*.
- Please see the Asian Citrus Psyllid information issued by the California Department of Food & Agriculture and the U.S. Department of Agriculture which is included in this packet, and sign the acknowledgement on the Registration Form.

Red Imported Fire Ants

- Orange County is currently within the regulated Red Imported Fire Ant (RIFA) Federal Quarantine area.
- At any time during the Event, plant products may be inspected for Fire Ants. Any plants found with Fire Ants will be confiscated.
- The California Department of Food and Agriculture has established a toll free RIFA hotline as part of eradication efforts in Orange County 1.800.491.1899.
- Report RIFA infestations to 1.888.434.7326.

- 2. Any other articles or commodities which are infested or exposed to infestation by ACP or HLB.**
- 3. Possible carriers shall include all appliances used in the growing, harvesting, processing and hauling of the host plants and plant parts and any green waste residues including but not limited to tractors, trailers, trucks, planting, picking and pruning equipment and processing machinery and any other article, thing or means of conveyance when it is determined by the Secretary or county agricultural commissioner to present a hazard of spreading live life stages of the ACP or HLB and the person in possession thereof has been so notified.**
- 4. Exemptions. The following articles are exempt from the provisions of this subsection:**
 - a. Host fruit commercially cleaned, graded and packed within the regulated area may move within or from the area.
 - b. Host fruit moved in bulk containers or bins which have been cleaned using normal packing house procedures.
 - c. Dying or dead plant material (green waste) that has been processed or handled or treated in a manner approved by the Secretary to eliminate live life stages of the ACP and is moved directly to a city or county sanitary landfill or State licensed compost facility within the quarantine area.

Green Scene 2020 Rules and Code of Conduct

Participation – Participation at the Green Scene Plant and Garden Expo (Event) is by invitation of the Friends of the Fullerton Arboretum. Participants must abide by the rules of the California State University, Fullerton (CSUF) and the Fullerton Arboretum. Violation of the rules by a participant may result in the participant not being invited back the next year. Past participation in the Event is no guarantee of an invitation to return the following year.

Participants – All participants in the Event (including, but not limited to, Commercial vendors, Educational organizations, Non-Profit Societies, Clubs and Food vendors) shall be referred to as “Vendors” throughout Event documents.

Vendor Sites – Vendors may request certain sites during the application process but the final determination of where a vendor is located rests solely with Arboretum management staff. During the Event, vendor activities must take place within the designated booth site and not in pathways, open areas or garden beds.

Arboretum Equipment – Equipment such as canopies, tables, chairs, etc., that are requested on the vendor Registration form shall be returned in good repair at the close of the Event. Vendors will only use equipment requested in advance at registration and not take additional tables, chairs, or equipment from other vendor booths.

Vendor Equipment – Vendors are responsible for getting all their equipment, product and people to their designated booth site. Arboretum staff, carts and/or vehicles are not available to transport product or people. All vendor equipment (canopies, tables, chairs, signage, displays, etc.) shall fit in its entirety within the booth space designated.

Vendor Vehicles – Traffic flow to and from vendor booths will be determined by Arboretum staff and vendors will comply with all directions received. Vendor vehicles may park only in designated areas for loading and unloading.

Liability Release Form – Every vendor, and all individuals assisting vendors, must complete a Liability Release Form in order to participate in the Event. This includes anyone who will be driving a vehicle on Arboretum property for set-up or take-down of vendor booths.

Abuse of Arboretum Staff – Arboretum staff, which consists of both paid employees and unpaid volunteers, strive to be courteous and respectful of vendors and their staff. It is expected that vendors will reciprocate and be just as courteous and respectful to Arboretum staff and volunteers. Verbal abuse of Arboretum staff will not be tolerated and may result in a vendor being removed from the Event and not being invited back to the Event the following year.

Arboretum Plants – Arboretum plants are not available for booth enhancement and demonstrations. No vendor shall ever harm any Arboretum plant. This means no pruning, picking, clipping, cutting, clearing, weeding, thinning, harvesting, etc., of any part of any plant in the Arboretum or elsewhere on the CSUF campus. Vendors shall not tie ropes around trees or use any tree in any way to secure canopies or display signs or merchandise.

Water Use – Vendors may request and pay for water use on the Registration form. Plants must be watered early in the morning before the Event opens and hoses returned coiled to faucet locations. Vendors must avoid excessive watering and not leave hoses running so that the ground becomes muddy.

Smoking – Smoking of any sort is not permitted at the Event or anywhere else on the CSUF campus. This is a CSUF policy and includes all forms of smoking, including vaping.

Take-Down of Vendor Booths – On the final day of the Event, vendors may not take down booths before 4:00 p.m. Vehicles will not be permitted inside for loading until 4:30 p.m. after visitors have vacated the Arboretum. Only one vehicle per booth may enter for take-down at a time.

Trash – Vendors will leave their booth space clean and free of any plant debris, cardboard or other refuse at the close of the Event. Trashcans are on site during the Event but all items carried in, must be carried out by the vendor, including empty boxes, plant clippings and flats. Vendors who violate this policy may be assessed a cleaning deposit if invited back the following year(s).

Balloons - Balloons of any type are not permitted.

Pets - No dogs or other pets shall be brought to the Event by vendors.

Bicycles - Bicycles must be parked in designated bike racks at the Arboretum entrance.

Liability – Vendors will hold harmless the Fullerton Arboretum Authority; the State of California; the California State University, Fullerton; the CSUF Associated Students, Inc.; the Friends of the Fullerton Arboretum; the City of Fullerton; the Fullerton Redevelopment Successor & Oversight Board; and all of their respective departments, organizations, boards, commissions, officers, agents, and employees from any liability whatsoever for any personal injury, and property damage which they may cause or suffer arising from their participation as a **VENDOR** during **Green Scene Plant and Garden Expo** at the Fullerton Arboretum, April 4 and 5, 2020 (includes setup days, April 2 and 3, 2020).

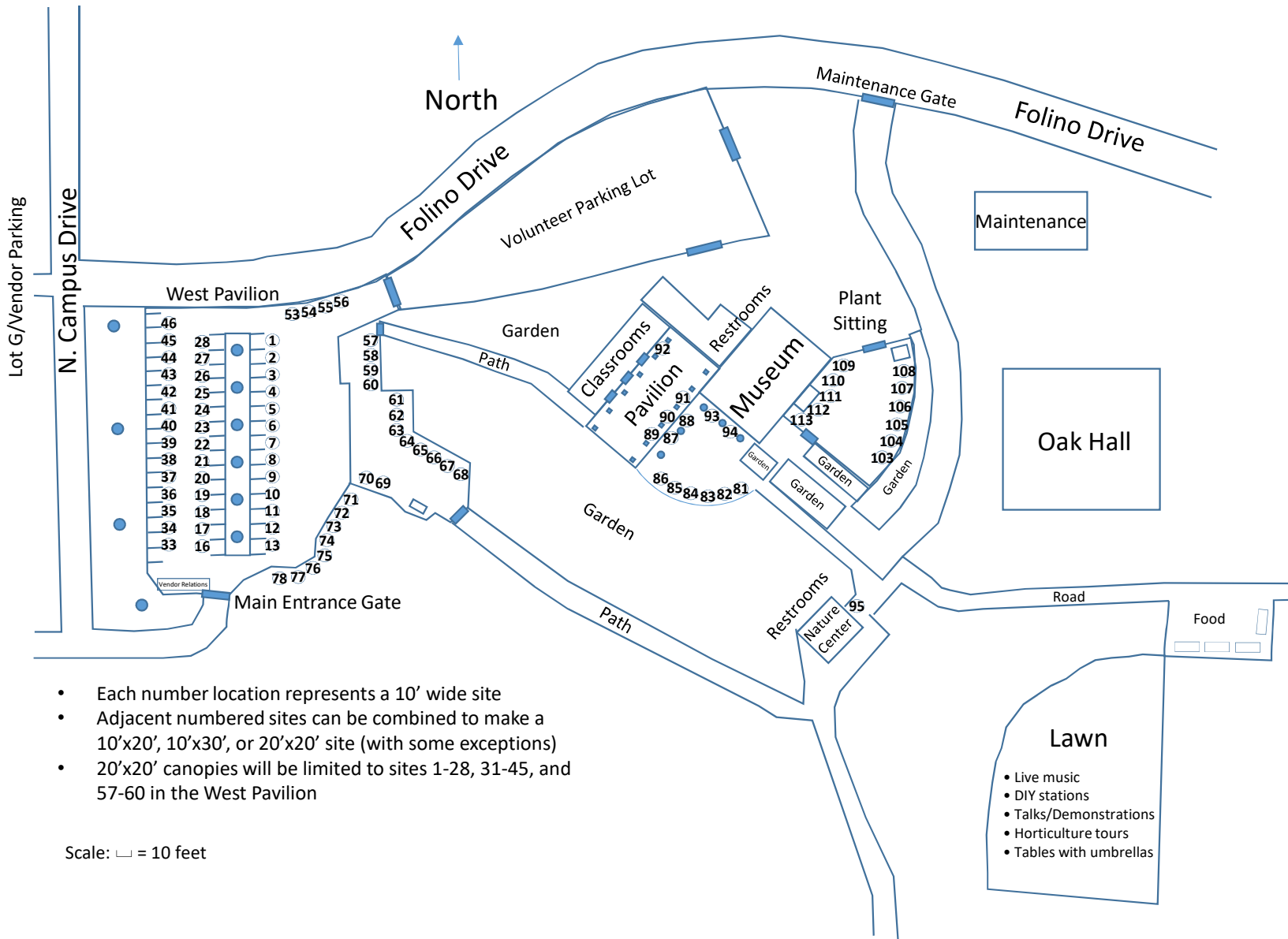

106 – 108	Space is located in the Sustainability Area. Vendor access is via the Maintenance gate. The display space surface is loose gravel and is flat. The maximum canopy height is somewhat restricted at 9' due to overhead pipes. Sun exposure is full sun all day. The distance from a vehicle to the vendor space is 15-25 yds. Water is available for an additional fee. Electricity is available for an additional fee.
109 - 110	Space is located in the Sustainability Area. Vendor access is via the Maintenance gate. The display space surface is loose gravel and is flat. The maximum canopy height is somewhat restricted at 9' due to overhead pipes. Sun exposure is full sun all day. The distance from a vehicle to the vendor space is 15-20 yds.
